




This presentation provides an overview of ECP0839, Auto Save.


The purpose of this ECP was for iRAPT to continuously auto save data during a user's session. This change is limited to the Time & Quality tab of the Energy Receiving Report.

This will allow the user's work to be preserved if they time out of the application or any system issue causes the application to become unavailable.



Auto Save functionality will apply to Time Statement page.

The application will use a System Property to determine interval for auto save.




Auto Save functionality will apply to the Statement of Quality Summary page.






The Success message for Auto Save will be different from messages for Save and Continue.
